- Rio Grande connects to the Rio Grande in North America.
- Amazon connects to the Amazon River in South America.
- Paraná connects to the Paraná River in South America.
- Niger connects to the Niger River in Africa.
- Congo connects to the Congo River in Africa.
- Zambezi connects to the Zambezi River in Africa.
- Danube connects to the Danube River in Europe.
- Rhine connects to the Rhine River in Europe.
- Mississippi connects to the Mississippi River in North America.
- Nile connects to the Nile River in Africa.
- Yenisei connects to the Yenisei River in Asia.
- Amur connects to the Amur River in Asia.
- Yellow River connects to the Yellow River in Asia.
- Yangtze connects to the Yangtze River in Asia.
- Ganges connects to the Ganges River in Asia.
- Murray-Darling connects to the Murray-Darling River in Australia.
- Indus connects to the Indus River in Asia.
